





Eolas - SEL ICB Antimicrobial Guidelines launch in Lambeth

Lambeth Together Medicines and Clinical Pathways Group has agreed adoption of the <u>SEL ICB</u> <u>Antimicrobial Guidelines</u>, hosted on the <u>Eolas</u> platform from May 2025.

All Lambeth primary care clinicians should now refer to the SEL ICB Antimicrobial guidelines, hosted on the Eolas platform (pronounced 'oh-lus').

Please ensure any local links or references to the previous Lambeth Antibiotic Guideline for Primary Care (2024 update) and the Lambeth STI Quick Reference Treatment Guideline (2022) guidelines are updated to <u>Eolas</u>. These <u>guidelines</u> have now been withdrawn from use.

This move ensures consistency across SEL, reduces duplication, and provides access to regularly updated, evidence-based guidance. Eolas also links to national resources including NICE CKS, BNF/BNFC, and BASHH.

Eolas guidelines can be accessed on both desktop and mobile (iOS and Android):

- <u>SELNet+</u>: Go to "Quick Links" > Antimicrobial Guidelines (only accessible with an email linked to SEL ICB)
- <u>Eolas Medical app</u> (requires account setup):
 - 1. Create an account within the app
 - 2. **Search for the organisation:** South East London Integrated Care Board
 - 3. Access the guides: Select SEL ICB Antimicrobial Guidelines
