

List of medicines falling under NHSE/I specialised commissioning **not** on the SEL Joint Medicines Formulary (out of area requests)

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The aim of this list is to advise prescribers on out of area prescribing requests for NHS England-commissioned medicines that are not included in the local SEL Joint Formulary. GPs may be requested to prescribe by outer SEL Trusts and should refer to the list below to determine RAGG status.

Requests for GPs to prescribe non-formulary drugs should be returned to the specialist and not prescribed in primary care. Inclusion of a drug on the list does not confer that a drug is commissioned for use within SEL trusts, please refer to the SEL joint formulary.
