Withdrawal of SEL Overactive Bladder (OAB) care pathway for adults in primary care (issued February 2020)

Following the development and approval of the SEL Acute Provider Collaborative (SEL APC) urology primary care guidelines for adults, the SEL Overactive Bladder (OAB) treatment pathway for women in primary care has been withdrawn

The SEL APC primary care adult urology guidelines include information on the diagnosis and pharmacological management of a number of urological conditions, including female lower urinary tract symptoms in primary care. The previous SEL treatment pathway for OAB in women has been incorporated within the SEL APC guidelines. The medication related content within the SEL APC urology guidelines has been reviewed and approved through the SEL IMOC.
