Health and Wellbeing Boards are the local authority statutory committees at place (borough) level, bringing together the local authorities, NHS and wider partners to develop strategies to improve the health and wellbeing of their populations in response to Joint Strategic Needs Assessments (JSNAs). The six borough Health and Wellbeing Boards produce the joint local health and wellbeing strategies for the ICB's local care partnerships

Health and Wellbeing Boards are responsible for holding NHS organisations to account for delivery of local health and care services.
