



SEL Bulletin - Eolas Medical Platform


The **SEL Primary Care Antimicrobial Prescribing Guidelines** is migrating from the MicroGuide® to a new platform called Eolas (*pronounced oh-luss*). This will be launched in South East London on **Wednesday 14th August 2024.**

The guidelines on Eolas Medical can be accessed via an app on phones and tablets (iOS and Android), as well as through a PC web browser. As well as hosting the **SEL Primary Care Antimicrobial Prescribing Guidelines** the Eolas Medical® platform offers a range of functionalities not previously available on Microguide®, including a knowledge base repository to other medical resources and guidelines such as BNF, BNFC, NICE and other national guidelines.

How to access the SEL primary care antimicrobial prescribing guidelines on Eolas Medical:

iOS and Android App access:

Download the "Eolas Medical" app from the Apple App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store (Android)



- Click on "Create a new account" and enter your email address. You might wish to sign up with your personal email address and add your professional/NHS one later.
- Enter the code sent to your email address to verify it.
- Scan the QR code below to link to the SEL primary care antimicrobial prescribing guideline or via this <u>direct access link</u> (<u>https://app.eolasmedical.com/access-link/2288a15b-9a5a-4b9c-b917-6470632093d0</u>)

Step 2: Scan the QR CodeScan the code after downloading the app to get access to your Space.

Web browser access:

- Users can access Eolas on a desktop via app.eolasmedical.com and sign in/register.
 - This allows the user to create a list of favourites for easy access to their most commonly used guidelines, as well as additional content (such as the BNF, BNFC and NICE).

Seamless Login Desktop Access

• Where direct access to the guidelines is needed without registering or logging into an account. On a desktop computers an auto-login token feature allows users to directly access the SEL antimicrobial guideline in a single click.
