

Guide 1: Hypoallergenic Formulas and Volume Guide

Red Amber Green (RAG) rating:

Green – Prescribe first-line for mild-moderate CMA. If an eHF is not tolerated/accepted for within 4 weeks, stop and trial an alternative eHF.

Amber – Consider if symptoms improved but did not resolve after at least 4 weeks on green product/s (eHF/s) or if strict criteria for AAF are met, which would likely require referral to secondary care.

Red – Do NOT prescribe in primary care without a written request with justification and regular review from a dietitian.

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Exclusively formula-fed infants: Recommended monthly (28 days) volumes to prescribe based on age

Age	General Advice	Formula quantity
0-3 months	If exclusively formula fed, 150ml/kg/day of a normal concentration	10 x 400g (4000g)
3-6 months	formula is required for this group.	13 x 400g (5200g)
6-9 months	Early weaning stage. Less formula as solid food intake increases. 800ml formula daily provides calcium requirement.	10 x 400g tins (4000g)
9-12 months	Advanced weaning stage. Less formula as solid food intake increases. 800ml formula daily provides calcium requirement.	8 x 400g tins (3200g)
12-14 months	Prescription will likely last until 14 months due to transition period to shop-bought plant-based milk alternative between months 12 to 14. Prescriptions lasting longer than this should only be provided if requested by a paediatric dietitian.	6 x 400g tins (2400g)

<u>Mixed-fed infants:</u> Recommended monthly (28 days) volumes to prescribe based on formula intake over 24 hours
