Referring to Local Services

Most infants with mild to moderate non-IgE-mediated cow's milk allergy (CMA) can be managed in primary care with prescribing support dietitian and/or local paediatric dietitian input. Referral to a paediatric dietitian should be made when CMA is suspected. This is essential as a dairy-free diet may be lower in energy, protein, calcium, vitamin B12 and iodine than a normal diet, requiring bespoke dietetic support.

The role of a paediatric dietitian in cow's milk allergy

- Support the diagnosis of non-IgE CMA
- Provide breastfeeding mothers with information on a nutritionally adequate dairy-free diet if required. •
- Provide dairy-free weaning advice. •
- Support with gradual re-introduction of dairy using the iMAP Milk Ladder at the appropriate age, and transitioning onto an appropriate plant-based milk alternative in place of hypoallergenic formula (HF). •

The role of the paediatric prescribing support dietitian in SEL

- Run Telephone Non-IgE CMA Rapid Access Clinic (RAC) ٠
- Support pathways for the management of CMA as set out by SEL guidelines. ٠
- Improve cost effectiveness of HF prescribing practices, as well as the quality of care provided to patients with suspected/ confirmed CMA. ٠
- Support practices in ensuring all prescriptions are appropriate, indicated, the correct volume and they are stopped at the appropriate time. •
- Contact parents or parent/ guardian of the patients where appropriate, to support the above, as part of GP audits. •
- Provide training on CMA to GP'S, health visitors and secondary care. ٠
