Plain English Explanation

This Integrated Care Board collects and stores information pertaining to staff for the purposes of HR, employment, recruitment, and training.

Information is collected and stored about prospective, current and past employees, including selfemployed and temporary staff.

Data is collected for purposes including recruitment and onboarding checks, occupational health referrals, staff training and payroll

6) Your Individual Rights	Right to Object
